

The Topographical Portrayal

The geography of Kegalle is mainly mountainous and plainly. Further, these features resemble the features of the transitional slopes between the high land and of the central hills. Therefore the geography in Kegalle has become assorted. The height of Kegalle from the sea level varies from 50m to 1800m. In general, the Western part of Kegalle has rivers and valleys, whereas the East part of Kegalle contains Mountainous areas. The divisional secretariats of Kegalle, Rambukkana, Warakapola, Ruwanwella, and Dehiowita belong to the low land areas of Kegalle District and Mawanella and Aranayaka belong to the hilly part of Kegalle. The highest place of Kegalle is located at Pallebadigala in the Deraniyagala Divisional secretariat division of the North-South part of Kegalle District.
